Fabian Molina, a 2019 HIVE prep graduate, is now a senior in high school with plans to study Astronautical Engineering at Stanford University. As he reflects on his journey so far, Fabian says he'll be "eternally grateful" for all the support he's received from his HIVE family.

It all started back in 2011 when Fabian enrolled at HIVE Prep as a first grader. Coming from a low-income background, Fabian and his family found that HIVE was really supportive of their socio-economic status. He lived with his mom who often had to work overtime to make ends meet. This meant she sometimes wouldn't get off work until 8 p.m. making it difficult for her pick up Fabian from school. Thanks to the supportive community at HIVE, Fabian was able to attend the after-school program. He remembers often being the last student there but that special arrangements were made for Mr. Saydel Mas, HIVE's Operations Manager and basketball coach, to take him home. This amazing support gave Fabian and his mom both the practical help they needed as well as the peace of mind knowing Fabian was safe and taken care of. Mr. Mas reflects, "I always felt that Fabian seemed mature beyond his years. He took things serious but also found

a median to have fun and make the best out of any situation. As he takes his next steps in life, I urge him to continue to be himself and to strive for great things. I know he makes his family and us here at HIVE proud, and as long as he continues to put in the hard work, the world's the limit to what he can achieve. While at HIVE Prep, Fabian was involved in the extracurricular STEM where he made robots, did a bit of programming and participated in competitions.
