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HIVE PREP'S PARTNERSHIP WITH PROJECT STEM


HIVE has joined in a recent partnership with Amazon Future Engineer-Project STEM, an awesome educational CS (computer science) and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) program that strives to provide all students with the opportunity to explore their potential. The non-profit organization focuses on "advancing equity in CS and STEM education by inspiring and empowering PreK-12 students and teachers in schools and districts across the US."*



HIVE was accepted to be a part of the first ever cohort in the country as Project STEM launches this new program. The partnership enables all HIVE students Grades 2-8 to take a CS course. Additionally, Grades 7 and 8 take an Artificial Intelligence (AI) course. The AI course offers students a unique opportunity to explore CS concepts and skills as well as create and interact with basic AI features like programming, coding and animation. From problem solving to creative exploration, students learn to express themselves and have fun engaging in real world issues.

As technology continues to grow in this digital world, HIVE is proud to be preparing students to succeed in CE and STEM careers at such young ages. What students experience at HIVE goes far beyond their eighth grade graduation and truly helps launch them toward a promising future.

KINDERGARTEN CHARACTER PROGRAM BRINGS SEL TO LIFE

This year, HIVE has launched a new program geared toward helping the "littlest learners" learn how to identify, manage, and express their emotions and the emotions of others. This new Kindergarten Character program takes social-emotional learning (SEL) from the curriculum and brings it to life! So far the program has been a great success and teachers are already looking forward to expanding it in the future.

How does it work? At the start of each new week, the kindergarten teachers introduce a new social-emotional learning focus. They then use the entire week to highlight the traits and characteristics of that SEL focus. On Fridays, teachers and students gather together in the school's cafeteria for a "Friday Celebration," where students get to interact and build relationships with kindergartners from other classes. The time is filled with songs, chants, cheers and dancing! The teachers even perform a self-planned skit that helps reinforce the SEL focus. At the end of their Friday Celebration, each teacher gets to award a student from their class that has exhibited the traits/ characteristics of the SEL focus for the week. Students and teachers alike have enjoyed these times together.
