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KINDERGARTNERS EARN TOP GROWTH SCORE IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

Last year, HIVE's kindergarten students earned the Top Score in the Star Reading Assessment—Growth in Miami-Dade County! Earning the Top Score in Growth for the Star Reading Assessments means that in 2023, HIVE earned the **greatest amount of growth** from the beginning of the year to the end of the year when compared with **all other public schools in Miami-Dade County**.

The process works like this. Students take Star Reading Assessments three times throughout the year. The first assessment is in September with the second in December and the third in April. After the first round of testing, HIVE teachers and staff analyze the data and create a game plan for moving forward. The data collection helps mold many different aspects. One is strategically grouping students based on their needs. In kindergarten, HIVE teachers have 45 minutes built into their school day for "centers." Centers provides a time for students to collaborate with other students working on a specific skill. During this time, teachers work with students in a smaller group setting and help them individually.

In addition to centers that are done in the teachers' classrooms every day, HIVE also has workshops. Workshops are run by HIVE paraprofessionals and staff four days of the week. This is a 30-minute time period where staff members pull out specific students from the classrooms. Workshops are intended and designed to help students close the learning gap on skills that they might have not mastered yet. Some examples of workshops include working on letter recognition, letter sounds, phonemic awareness and After the second round of Star Reading Assessments are finished, HIVE teachers and staff once again gather and analyze the data. HIVE is constantly changing small group arrangements to be more intentional on how and what learning is going on. With data driven implementation, students receive the help they need in order to grow!

The third and final Star Reading Assessments showed these strategies are working! Current Assistant Principal Charlene Manaoat was a kindergarten teacher last school year. She shares, "We are very excited to have earned the Top Score in 2023 Star Reading Assessment—Growth in Miami-Dade County! Our students, teachers and staff have worked really hard all year long and it's amazing to see the work pay off!" Director of Schools Carlos Gonzalez further adds, "To earn the highest kindergarten growth scores within the third largest school district in the country is truly exceptional! This validates all of the hard work put in by these students, teachers and families."
